

B-Audio, the Belgian audiological society and affiliated with the Royal Belgian Society of Oto-Rhino-Laryngology, Head and Neck Surgery B-ORL is responsible for the processing of personal data as shown in this privacy statement. The processing of personal data, such as the name, email address, of a data subject is in line with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

In the following 'member' applies to both the paying member and the student (free of charge)

Personal data that B-Audio processes:

B-Audio processes your personal data because you use our services and / or because you provide these to us yourself. We process the following data:

- First and last name
- E-mail address
- IP address (automatically)
- With regard to your personal account we store your
 - o email address and your password (hashed)
 - o your profession (clinical audiology, ENT, Education, Hearing Aid professional, Industry, Research)
 - o Membership of Audiology Professional or Scientific Association
- Personal data that you actively provide, for example by creating a profile on this website, adding information on your thesis (title, name, abstract)
- Information about your activities (e.g. vacancies, conferences) on our website

For what purpose and on what basis we process personal data

B-Audio processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- Handling your payment
- Offer you the possibility to create an account
- Being able to e-mail you if this is necessary to be able to perform our services
- To deliver goods and services to you

B-Audio also processes other user data, such as conferences, vacancies, and certificates of attendance.

Special and / or sensitive personal data that we process

Our website and / or service only collects data about website visitors over 16 years of age. However, we cannot check whether a visitor is older than 16. We therefore advise parents to be involved in their children's online activities in order to prevent information about children being collected without parental consent. Keeping and removing personal data

B-Audio does not store your personal data for longer than is strictly necessary to realize the purposes for which your data are collected.

Each (potential) member makes an account. This account can be activated and deactivated.

Membership grants access to the information on the website via the account (e.g. events). Personal data is stored for the duration of membership and while the account is activated. Please contact info@baudio.be to remove all information of the portfolio (data which you (subject) have (has) added voluntarily, such as title, abstract of bachelor- master-, or PhD thesis) from the database.

Sharing of personal data with third parties:

B-audio does not sell or give your data to third parties and only provides information if this is necessary for the implementation of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation. For example, if the subject enrolls in a third-party event (e.g. B-ORL conference) which offers reduction for B-Audio members, then proof of membership shall be provided to the third party.

B-Audio is also a premium affiliate of the *International Society of Audiology* (ISA, <https://isa-audiology.org/>).

The Premium Affiliate offering includes online access to the International Journal of Audiology (IJA). In order to allow online access to IJA your email address is shared with the International Society of Audiology. Please check the separate consent on the registration form if you agree.

Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use

B-audio only uses technical and functional cookies and analytical cookies that do not infringe on your privacy. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit this website. The cookies we use are necessary for the technical operation of the website and your ease of use. They ensure that the website works properly and, for example, remember your preferences.

View, modify or delete data

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. In addition, you have the right to withdraw your consent for data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by B-audio.
